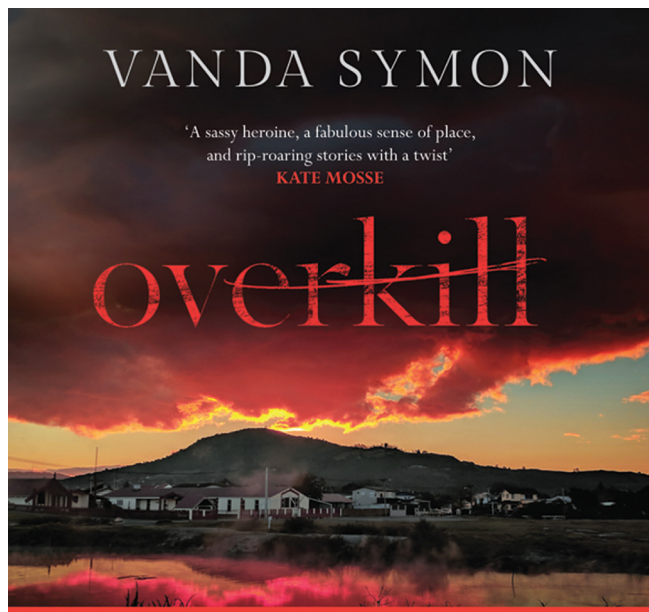

What did you like best about this book?

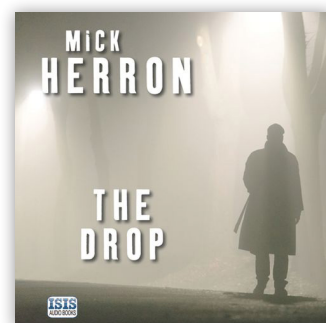
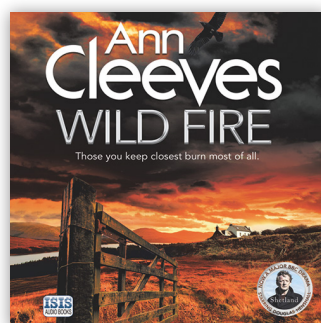
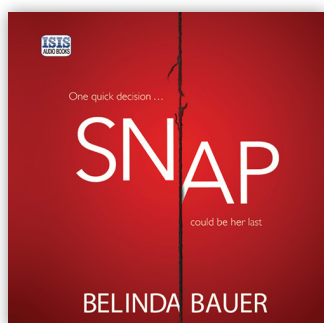
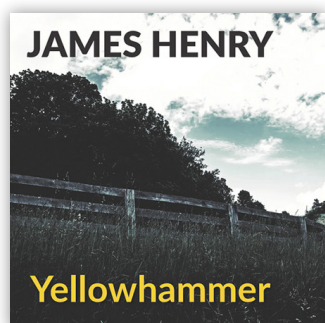
