Just Like You

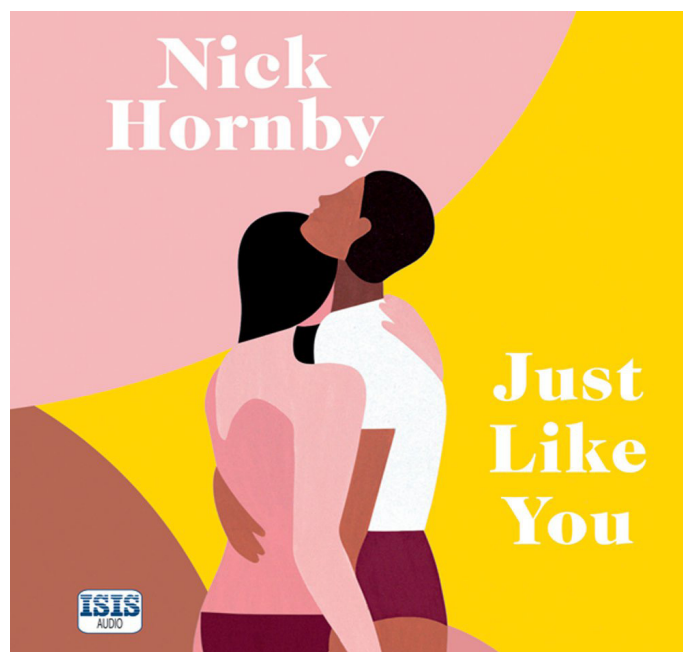
