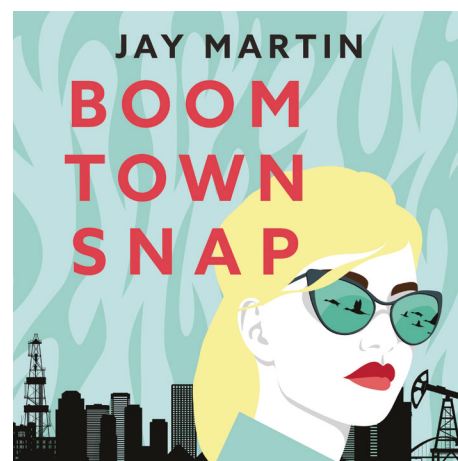
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Boom Town Snap

Synopsis

When Georgie's boss-turned-lover, Nico, offers her a high-stakes job in Canada, she wants to say no.
